Overview

The VAST Course uses the dynamic environment of simulation to explore key factors that contribute towards safe anaesthesia provision. The course is suitable for anaesthesia providers of all levels of training.

By the end of this three-day course participants will be able to:

- Recognise key non-technical skills applicable to anaesthesia
- Demonstrate a systematic approach to patient assessment
- Plan and prepare prior to delivery of anaesthesia
- Utilise a systematic approach to managing the unwell patient
- Communicate effectively for optimal team function

The pilot VAST Courses will the first time be delivered in its entirety. They are being offered with the help of CASIEF and Dalhousie University and are endorsed by the WFSA, the University of Rwanda and the Rwanda Society of Anaesthesiologists
